

Garry Davis Hustled Out Of Assembly by Police

PARIS, Nov. 19—Garry Davis, self-styled citizen of the world, popped up in the crowded United Nations Assembly hall today shouting for a one-world organization. He was promptly removed from the room by police officers.

Davis, a 26-year-old United States Air Force veteran of World War II, appeared on a side balcony and shouted to surprised delegates and spectators: "Pass the word to the people —one world!"

He was hurried through a side exit, still struggling. After having been held for more than four hours, he was released.
